All CRC members are required to:

- Promptly address any issue they have with another member’s behaviour directly or with the assistance of their coach, then escalating it quickly to Rowing Director and further to Committee if it is not resolved.
- Establish at least a working / rowing relationship with any member with whom they have had a dispute.
- Abstain from consuming illegal drugs.
- Assist with keeping the club house tidy by removing their rubbish, and belongings when not in use at the Club.
- Report any risks or issues they see with the Club’s operation as soon as possible to Coach / Rowing Director / Captain / Committee Member.

In addition members who are CRC Coaches are required to:

- Be aware of and adhere to rules, policies and procedures associated with “COACHING ACTIVITIES” as outlined over page.
- Perform duties with professionalism, impartiality and integrity.
- Avoid real or apparent conflicts of interest.
- Act in a manner which will bear the closest public scrutiny.

A failure to comply with any requirement of this CRC Code of Member Behaviour may subject the member to the following disciplinary actions:

- reprimand
- suspension
- termination of membership
